THE MILLIGAN BLOCK AND ADJACENT BUILDINGS -- The Italianate Milligan Block (1883) is noteworthy for its use of brick and pressed metal details. Its extensively decorated cornice adds height to the three-story construction and the angled entrance bay helps the building dominate this corner location. Of the four modest Queen Anne buildings adjacent, the first contains a charming pressed metal and slate-roofed tower. The rhythmic projecting bays on the other three add visual interest to the second story streetscape.
