ODD FELLOWS LODGE -- The Victorian Romanesque building, designed by William A. Stevens in 1889, housed the meetings and activities of one of Huntington's most active fraternal lodges. The Odd Fellows movement was extremely popular during the nineteenth century, providing opportunities for fellowship, service, insurance and other needs. The prominent round-arched window on the third floor, with its four part round central section, portrays symbols of the organization in stained glass.
