**WILLIAM STREET SCHOOL - 521 William Street** -- The oldest school building still standing in Huntington, the earliest section of this structure was built in 1895, when it was known as the William Street School. 1926 saw a major addition and the name changed to the Horace Mann School. Many students first discovered the wonders of learning in this brick building which features an imposing bell tower, round at the base and octagonal at the top. Rock-faced limestone arches are a prevalent theme of the architecture, which is a blend of Romanesque and Queen Anne styles.
