HOTEL HUNTINGTON -- The Wabash & Erie Canal was still in operation when the central part of this building was constructed in 1848. Built in the Greek Revival style, the Market Street facade is graced with pedimented windows, and wide eaves which are supported by scrollwork brackets. Between 1883 and 1900, several additions were constructed which brought it to its present size.
